Summer Examinations:

Some courses, mostly BTEC and Applied subjects, require students in year 12 sit their first exam. The school does not have any control over these external examination dates, and it is not possible to rearrange these examinations for any reason, as they are organised for the whole country to take at the same time. Students will be given a timetable for these exams shortly.

Sixth Form Enrichment Programme:

As part of our sixth form enrichment programme all year 12 students will be taking part in 2 weeks of planned activities.

Work Experience:

In January, we asked all year 12 students to arrange a work experience placement from Monday 22nd to Friday 26th May, and relating to their future choices where possible.
