

Dear Parent / Carer



19th & 20th January 2023 - Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccination in school.

We are inviting your child to be vaccinated against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). HPV infection can cause cervical cancer, head cancer, neck cancer or anal / genital cancer in later life. This cancer prevention vaccination is offered to all students from Year 8.

The HPV vaccination is a two-dose course. Dose one is given in year 8 and dose two when your child goes into year 9. To get the best protection, your child needs both vaccines.

Please discuss this immunisation with your child and complete the online form at: https://www.kentcht.nhs.uk/imms before midnight on 13th January 2023 to accept or decline.

Please submit either a YES consent or a NO consent as we will continue to invite your child to be vaccinated unless we hear from you. This may mean that we will call you to obtain verbal consent over the phone.

If we are unable to vaccinate your child at school you will receive an email with a link to our online clinic booking site where you can book an immunisation appointment.
