Dear Parent/Carer

As we head towards the end of term, please make sure you look out for our end of term newsletter which will update you on the varied and exciting events that have taken place since September. We will send this to all parents and carers at the end of term and share on our website.

### End of Term

The last day of this term is Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December. Students will be dismissed from school at 12.25pm. Please ensure your child has an appropriate arrangement in place to get home safely. Students entitled to a free school meal can collect this from The Galley at breaktime. As a reminder, below are our expectations for student dress on this day:

The last day of this term is a non-uniform day. The theme for the day is 'Christmas'. Students are invited to wear a Christmas jumper or Christmas themed clothing, if they wish to. We ask for a donation of £1 which will be donated to the Save the Children charity. On non-uniform days, we <u>do</u> <u>not</u> allow:

- baseball caps or woolly hats
- excessive makeup, false nails or jewellery as per our uniform expectations
- offensive slogans
- high-heeled shoes, boots or sliders

### Term 3
