## ClassCharts

Last term, we launched ClassCharts, a powerful educational platform aimed at enhancing the way we communicate and collaborate with you to support your child's academic journey.

ClassCharts is designed to strengthen the connection between the school, parents, and students. It serves as a central hub for important information and insights into your child's education. With ClassCharts, you will have access to several features, including:

- Positive and Negative Behaviour: *keep track of your child's behaviour at school, with the ability to view both positive and negative incidents.*
- Detentions: get information about any detentions your child may have received, ensuring that consequences for behaviour are clear and consistent.
- Attendance and punctuality: monitor your child's attendance to ensure they are attending classes regularly and staying engaged in their education.
- Timetable and Class Access: view your child's class schedule and access information about specific classes they are enrolled in.
- On-Report Cards: stay informed about your child's academic performance via digital on-report cards.
