



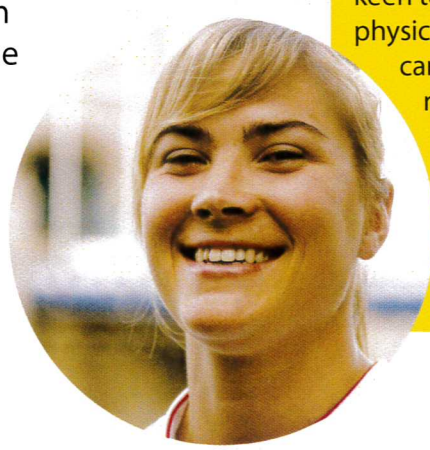
# Celebrating expertise and dedication in schools
