### **UCL Trip Friday 2 March 2018**

As part of preparing students for their future we are offering an opportunity to visit University College London on Friday 2 March 2018. The students will visit the university campus where they will have a tour conducted by current students. As part of the trip we will also be visiting the University Grant Museum, the University's Zoology Museum. Students are required to pay £12.00 to cover costs for the trip, paid in advance. This includes transport costs and covering the costs of teachers supervising the trip.

Students will be required to bring lunch with them or money to purchase food. Students that have free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. Students are not required to wear school uniform and may travel to school on the day of the trip in casual clothes. We ask that clothing is practical and appropriate for learning and that students remain ambassadors for their Academy. We therefore request:

- No strappy/STRAPLESS tops or short skirts/shorts
- No hats
- No excessive makeup, FALSE NAILS or jewellery
- No offensive slogans
- No ripped jeans

We will be leaving school by minibus at 9.00 am and then catching a train from Chatham Station. Students will return to Chatham station at 3.04pm. Please indicate on the attached slip whether you will be collecting your child from the station or are happy for them to make their own way home from the station.

If you give permission for your child to take part in this visit, please complete the attached form and return by Friday 9 February. There are limited places and these will be issued on a first-come first-served basis. Payments should be made via Parent Pay by logging in with your user name and password and selecting the trip details 'Year 10 UCL Trip', or paid in cash to Student Services.
