I am pleased to enclose your child's Grade Card from Term 3 at The Victory Academy.

On this Report you will find information relating to:

- Subject Targets for the end of Year
- Progress towards the end of Year Target (On Track)
- Attitude to Learning grade (ATL)
- Homework grade

(Target grades may have a + or -. + is at the top of the scale, - is at the bottom end of the grade. Progress towards Target could be Significantly above Target (Sig +), Above Target (Above), On Target (On) or Below Target (Below))

Pupils are graded on a 9-1 scale, 9 being the highest and 1 the lowest. Should the pupil not yet meet the criteria for grade 1, they are graded on the 'Runway scale' R1-R3, where R1 is closest to reaching main scale and R3 in furthest away.

Pupil target grades are calculated based on KS2 results from Year 6 at primary school. A pupil's progress towards their target is based upon a student's expected progress levels from the KS2 starting point.
