As you are aware, our school is now using a blend of face to face and online teaching methods to ensure all of our students continue to access their regular learning.

However, there are some restrictions on their Design and Technology and Art lessons where students are out of these specialist classrooms. So, as best to support your young person the two departments would like to make you aware of some basic equipment which would be very useful to help students fully achieve their learning potential whilst working from home.

The following items are;

- Plain paper
- Pencil
- Colour pencils (if possible)
- Ruler
- Needle and sewing thread
- Spare/old clothes to practice stitching
- Cardboard (cereal/pizza etc.)
- Cellotape
- Glue (glue stick would be ideal)
- Scissors
- Food ingredients that would coincide with student's normal lessons
