Dear Sixth Form Parent/Carer

I am writing to update you on arrangements for your young person's education over this second period of national lockdown.

The students' safety and education are of paramount importance to us, and therefore we are making some minor changes to enable students to continue to access their education safely. From Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November, students will still need to attend all timetabled lessons in person, but will be able to spend some allocated study periods working from home. This will enable us to reduce the numbers of students accessing the school's Sixth Form study centre at any one time.

In most cases we will be allocating home study periods during Learning Period 1 (09:00 - 10:40) and Learning Period 3 (13:20 - 15:05). In exceptional circumstances, some students may be required to have a full day of home study. We are re-issuing student timetables to show these changes. We would ask that students are working purposefully if they are at home during these times.

We are continuing to provide support for all students both in person and via our digital learning environment. We thank you for your home support during this time.
