Kent to Kings Opportunity for Year 12 students: If you meet the following criteria, speak to Miss Clark or Miss Mulley about applying for the Kent to Kings programme for free online mentoring to prepare for university, including a summer school in 2022!

To be eligible to apply, you must:

- be in Year 12 as of September 2021
- attend a non-selective state school/college in Medway or Swale
- be currently studying A-Levels
- have a minimum of eight GCSE grades at 5-9
- would be the first generation in their family to attend university (siblings can have attended university)
